

## CELLULAR PROCESSING

Step One: Look up in a good dictionary and Clean Slate Cell

Step Two:

1. **Connected to a cell, what have you done?**
2. **Connected to a cell, what have you restrained?**
3. **Connected to a cell, what haven't you said?**

Run 1-3 repetitively to a win

Step Three:

1. **Connected to you, what has a cell done?**
2. **Connected to you, what has a cell restrained?**
3. **Connected to you, what hasn't a cell said?**

Run 1-3 repetitively to a win

Step Four:

Discuss each of the following items, first the negative then the positive, picking up and handling all Vital Fundamentals:

**Injuring cells**  
**Damaging cells**  
**Starving cells**

**Repairing cells**  
**Protecting cells**  
**Feeding cells**

**Destroying cells**  
**Poisoning cells**

**Creating cells**  
**De-toxifying cells**

Step Five:

Run repetitively to a win:

**“From where could a cell communicate to a spiritual being?”**

**“From where could a spiritual being communicate to a cell?”**

Step Six: Repeat Steps One to Five on **‘Cellular Organization’**
